Since the summer of 2003, we have asked you, the kids of Local 9 members, to help us create awareness about safety by sending us your artwork. We hope you'll put your good ideas on paper so we can use your safety poster to remind everyone about the need to work and play safely.

#### AGE CATEGORIES

Entries will be judged in two age classes: Kids 8 years and under  
Kids 9 - 14

The winners in each age category of the 2010 Safety Poster Contest will be awarded cash prizes as follows:

First Place	\$100
Second Place	\$75
Third Place	\$50

#### RULES

- The contest is open to the families of active PPWC Local 9 members only. To be eligible for the contest, the posters must address safety in the workplace, at home or at play. The artwork may be done either in black and white or in colour. The wording on the poster should be limited.
- Each poster must be submitted on 8-1/2 x 11 inch white unruled paper. You can put in as many entries as you would like but the following information must appear on the back of each poster entered
  - Name
  - Age
  - Address
  - Local 9 member's name
- Posters not complying with the above criteria, will not be judged.
- Posters will be judged on:
  - a. Content of safety message
  - b. Originality
  - c. Art work
- All posters become the property of PPWC Local 9.
- Mail or deliver entries to Susan at the Local 9 office - address below.  
**Deadline for entries is 15 August 2010.**

In the past few years, all entries have been used to make up the Local 9 Safety calendar showing the artists' name. Names can be withheld upon request. These calendars are given to all members and are used throughout the mills. **We look forward to hearing from all of you so get your crayons ready!**
